Technology is Rapidly Changing. Electronic waste is now one of the fastest growing segments of our nation's waste stream.

Reduce Pollution. Electronic waste products contain hazardous materials such as lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium and cadmium. Disposal of equipment containing cathode ray tubes, such as computer monitors and televisions, is prohibited.

Conserve Natural Resources. Electronic waste contains steel, glass, plastic and precious metals such as gold, silver, platinum and palladium that can be recovered and recycled.

Important Reminder: Many electronic products (computers, cell phones, PDAs, etc.) are used to store personal information. Before donating or recycling your equipment, remember to remove all sensitive and personal information from its memory.
